***Run, Boy, Run* by Uri Orlev YP FIC ORLEV**

Based on the true story of a nine-year-old boy who escapes the Warsaw Ghetto and must survive throughout the war in the Nazi-occupied Polish countryside.

***Storm-blast* by Curtis Parkinson**

YP FIC PARKINSON A day of snorkeling turns to horror as a sudden storm strands three teenagers in the Caribbean.

***This World We Live In* by Susan Beth Pfeffer**

YP FIC PFEFFER When the moon's gravitational pull increases, causing massive natural disasters on Earth, Miranda and her family struggle to survive in a world without cities or sunlight, and wonder if anyone else is still alive.

***Nation* by Terry Pratchett YP FIC PRATCHET**

After a devastating tsunami destroys all that they have ever known, Mau, an island boy, and Daphne, an aristocratic English girl, together with a small band of refugees, set about rebuilding their community and all the things that are important in their lives.

***Lost in the River of Grass* by Ginny Rorby**

YP FIC RORBY When two Florida teenagers become stranded on a tiny island in the Everglades, they attempt to walk ten miles through swampland to reach civilization.

***The Girls of No Return* by Erin Saldin**

YP FIC SALDIN A troubled sixteen-year-old girl attending a wilderness school in the Idaho mountains must finally face the consequences of her complicated friendships with two of the other girls at the school.

***Hunt for the Bamboo Rat* by Graham Salisbury**

YP FIC SALISBURY Zenji Watanabe, seventeen, is sent from Hawaii to the Philippines to spy on the Japanese during World War II and, after he is captured and tortured, must find a way to survive months of being lost in the jungle behind enemy lines.

***I Have a Bad Feeling About This* by Jeff Strand**

YP FIC STRAND Everything unathletic sixteen-year-old Henry was dreading about survival camp turns out to be true--or even worse--when armed killers arrive and survival takes on a whole new meaning for the campers.

***Are You Going to Kiss Me Now?* by Sloane Tanen**

YP FIC TANEN After winning an essay contest, high school junior Francesca Manning finds herself stranded on an island with five celebrities when their plane crashes on the way to a charity event.

***The Cay* by Theodore Taylor YP FIC TAYLOR**

When the freighter on which they are traveling is torpedoed by a German submarine during World War II, a twelve-year-old white boy, blinded by a blow on the head, and an old Negro are stranded on a small desert island in the Caribbean where the boy acquires a new kind of vision, courage, and love from his old companion.

***The Darwin Expedition* by Diane Tullson**

YP FIC TULLSON When an accident leaves Tej and Liam stranded in the wilderness, they must survive the elements, and the bear that is chasing them, long enough to get back to civilization.

***The Maestro: A Novel* by Tim Wynne-Jones**

YP FIC WYNNE A runaway boy comes across a famous musician who lives on a beautiful lake. When the Maestro dies, the boy searches desperately for a way to keep the cabin. His plan leads to a terrifying and unforgettable confrontation.

***Beauty Queens* by Libba Bray YP FIC BRAY**

When a plane crash strands thirteen teen beauty contestants on a mysterious island, they struggle to survive, to get along with one another, to combat the island's other diabolical occupants, and to learn their dance numbers in case they are rescued in time for the competition.

***The Goats* by Brock Cole YP FIC COLE** Stripped and marooned on a small island by their fellow campers, a boy and a girl form an uneasy bond that grows into a deep friendship when they decide to run away and disappear without a trace.

***The Living* by Matt de la Peña**

YP FIC DELAPENA After an earthquake destroys California and a tsunami wrecks the luxury cruise ship where he is a summer employee, high schooler Shy confronts another deadly surprise.

***A Girl Named Disaster* by Nancy Farmer**

YP FIC FARMER While fleeing from Mozambique to Zimbabwe to escape an unwanted marriage, Nhamo, an eleven-year-old Shona girl, struggles to escape drowning and starvation and in so doing comes close to the luminous world of the African spirits.

***Black Ice* by Becca Fitzpatrick**

YP FIC FITZPATR Britt goes hiking in the Grand Tetons of Wyoming with her ex-boyfriend Calvin, but trouble arises when she is caught in a blizzard, taken hostage by fugitives, finds evidence of murders, and learns whom to trust and whom to love.

***The Wild* by Christopher Golden**

YP FIC GOLDEN Seventeen-year-old Jack London makes the arduous journey to the Yukon's gold fields in 1893, becoming increasingly uneasy about supernatural forces in the wilderness that seem to have taken a special interest in him.

***The Lastling* by Philip Gross YP FIC GROSS**

Having traveled to a war-torn area of the Himalayas with her uncle to hunt exotic game, fourteen-year-old Paris befriends a lost twelve-year-old Buddhist monk and a young yeti, from whom she learns about humanity and friendship.

***Into the Forest* by Jean Hegland**

YP FIC HEGLAND Nell and Eva struggle to survive as society begins to decay and collapse around them. There is talk of a war overseas and upheaval in Congress, but it still comes as a shock when the electricity runs out and gas is nowhere to be found.

***Downriver* by Will Hobbs YP FIC HOBBS** Jessie and the other rebellious teenage members of a wilderness survival school team abandon their adult leader, hijack his boats, and try to run the dangerous white water at the bottom of the Grand Canyon.

***The Winter Road* by Terry Hokenson**

YP FIC HOKENSON Willa, still grieving over the death of her older brother and the neglect of her father, decides to fly a small plane to fetch her mother from Northern Ontario, but when the plane crashes she is all alone in the snowy wilderness.

***The Winter Horses* by Philip Kerr YP FIC KERR**

Kalinka, a Ukrainian Jewish girl on the run from the Nazis, finds unlikely help from two rare Przewalski horses.

***If We Survive* by Andrew Klavan**

YP FIC KLAVAN When revolutionaries seize control of a country in Central America where sixteen-year-old Will is serving at a mission, he and the other volunteers find themselves in a desperate race to escape the violence and return home.

***The Killing Sea* by Richard Lewis YP FIC LEWIS**

In the aftermath of the 2004 tsunami in Sumatra, two teenagers, American Sarah and Acehnese Ruslan, meet and continue together their arduous climb inland, where Ruslan hopes to find his father and Sarah seeks a doctor for her brother.

***Walkabout* by James Vance Marshall**

YP FIC MARSHALL Two children are the sole survivors of an air-crash in the Australian desert. Lost, hungry and tired to exhaustion, they face certain death, when suddenly they meet a young aboriginal boy on his walkabout.

***Camel Rider* by Prue Mason YP FIC MASON** Adam from Australia and Walid from Bangladesh, must rely on one another when war breaks out and they find themselves in the desert with no water, little food, and no common language.

***Taken* by David Massey YP FIC MASSEY** Rio Cruz and a crew of young disabled veterans are teamed up to sail around the world for charity--but when they are kidnapped by a psychotic African warlord and his band of child soldiers the trip of a lifetime turns into a nightmare journey into the African jungle.

***The Island Keeper* by Harry Mazer**

YP FIC MAZER Longing to disappear after the death of her beloved younger sister, 16-year-old Cleo runs away from her overprotective and oppressive family and goes to a remote island where she is the only human inhabitant.

***Snow Bound* by Harry Mazer YP FIC MAZER**

Two teenagers caught in a snowstorm in a desolate area face a fight for survival.

***Red Midnight* by Ben Mikaelson**

YP FIC MIKAELSE After soldiers kill his family, twelve-year-old Santiago and his four-year-old sister flee Guatemala in a kayak and try to reach the United States.

***Seaborn* by Craig Moodie YP FIC MOODIE**

A sudden storm sweeps Luke's father overboard, leaving Luke to figure out how to survive on a damaged boat in the Gulf Stream while dealing with his feelings of guilt.

***Survive* by Alex Morel YP FIC MOREL** A troubled girl is stranded in an arctic winter terrain after a plane crash and must fight for survival with the only other boy left alive.

***Island of the Blue Dolphins* by Scott O'Dell**

YP FIC ODELL Left alone on a beautiful but isolated island, a young Indian girl spends eighteen years, surviving through her enormous courage and self-reliance.
